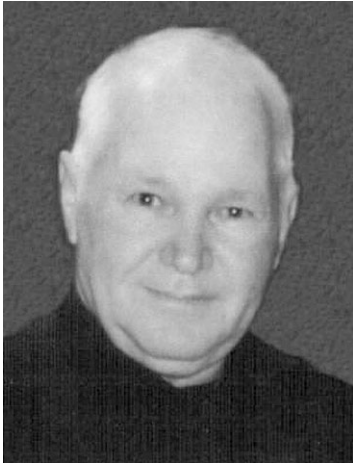


DOW "PAPA" WEBSTER BELLAH
