

FRED EUGENE BRUMMELL



Fred Eugene Brummell, 90, a retired executive vice president of First National Bank of Decatur for 38 years, died March 27, 2007 in Decatur.

Mr. Brummell was born October 20, 1916 in Pittsburg. He married Rowena Moore on March 16, 1940 in Decatur. He was a U. S. Navy veteran and served with the National Guard 49th Armored Division during WWII. He was honored in 1979 as Decatur Citizen of the Year and honored by the Decatur City Council as a loyal supporter for over 40 years of the following organizations, Decatur Fire Department, Wise County Sheriff's Posse, Christmas Cheer, Decatur Chamber of Commerce, Easter Seal Society, Decatur Jaycees and Wise County Reunion Committee. He served as former Decatur Fire Chief and was preceded in death by his brothers, James Jake and Gladwyn C. Brummell.

Survivors include his wife of 67 years, Rowena Brummell of Decatur; son, James M.
