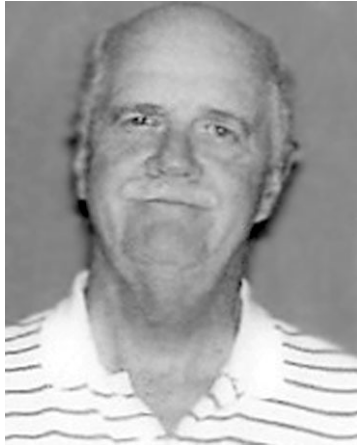


LARRY STUBBLEFIELD
