

## LAOUIDA “MICKEY” ROBINSON

LaOuida “Mickey” Robin-son, 90, passed away Saturday, October 6, 2007 in Decatur.

Mickey was born on October 21, 1916 in Wortham to the late Charles and Lorena (Byers) Ragsdale. She married Tom Robinson in 1970 in Lubbock. He preceded her in death on November 29, 1980. Mickey was Vice President for Harry Newton Engineering. She was the first woman in the State of Texas to learn how to use a computer. Mickey was a member of the Community Church of Possum Kingdom, PK Womens Club, Fire Hall Auxiliary, and Charlie’s Angels.
