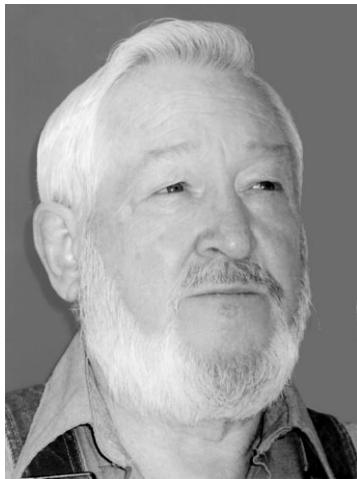


ROBERT (BOB) GASPER
