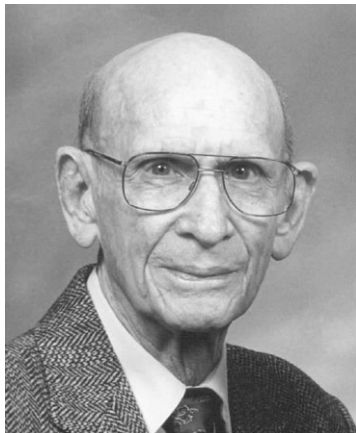


ROBERT JAY MANN JR.



Robert Jay Mann, Jr., 83, of Haltom City, died April 24, 2007 in Haltom City. He was a retired auto assembler for General Motors.

Mr. Mann was born into the family of Robert Jay and Rosa May Mann, near Sycamore, in Wise County, raised and educated in Decatur. He volunteered and became an aircraft mechanic in the Army Air Force during WWII. He married Ella Marie Stone in Decatur on March 8, 1947.
