**CLIFTON:** Betty Jane Chase Endres, 86, originally of Alvord, died Monday, June 23, 2008 in Clifton, Texas.

Betty was born September 24, 1921 in Yehola, Oklahoma to Leonard Earl and Margaret Ethel (Threadgill) Chase. She graduated from Central High School in Oklahoma City in 1939 and attended Blackwell-Davis Business College. She was employed at Southwestern Bell in Oklahoma City as a bookkeeper until 1946.
