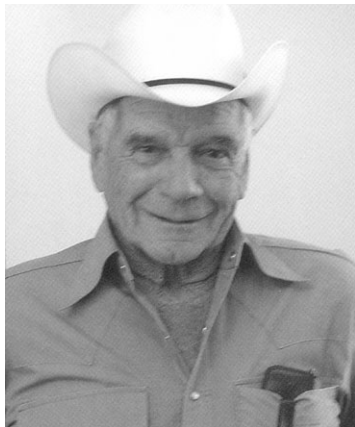


JACK WAYNE EAVENSON

Jack Wayne Eavenson, 80, of Alvord, died Monday, March 3, 2008.
