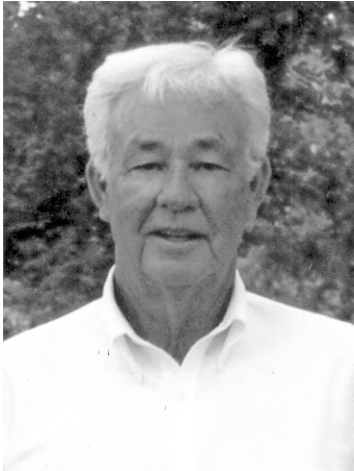


# JOE HARVEY ARMSTRONG
