FLORENCE, AZ: Charles Roscoe (Chuck) Brewer, 61, of Florence, Arizona, previously of Bridgeport, died Saturday, April 23, 2011, in Apache Junction, Arizona, from cancer.

Chuck was born January 31, 1950, in Bridgeport to Elmer Joseph (Bill) Brewer and Nellie Katherine (Mollie) Dethloff Brewer. He attended Bridgeport ISD and then furthered his education at Weatherford College. He was a Vietnam Veteran who served his country as a U.S. Marine for four years.

After the Marine Corps, he began his aggregate career working for companies such as TXI, Tradco Vulcan, Gifford Hill, Lattimore, and over thirty years at Hanson. He worked in many different places including Saudi Arabia, Jamaica, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arizona and Texas. Chuck was a big fan of rodeos

and in his younger years loved any opportunity to ride a bull. He was an avid sports fan and long time Dallas Cowboys and Texas Rangers fan.

Chuck is preceded in death by his father.
