POOLVILLE: Salvador Antonio Esquivel, 52, of Poolville died Wednesday, April 13, 2011, in Fort Worth.

Esquivel was born in Santa Rosa de Lima, El Salvador on August 1, 1958, to parents Ramon R. and Carlota (Hernandez) Esquivel. After high school Mr. Esquivel took one year of accounting at San Salvador University. In 1978, Esquivel was the leading dancer in the Salvadorian Folkloric Ballet. Later he worked in real estate property maintenance and construction. He specialized in custom construction and remodeling.
