1945-2012

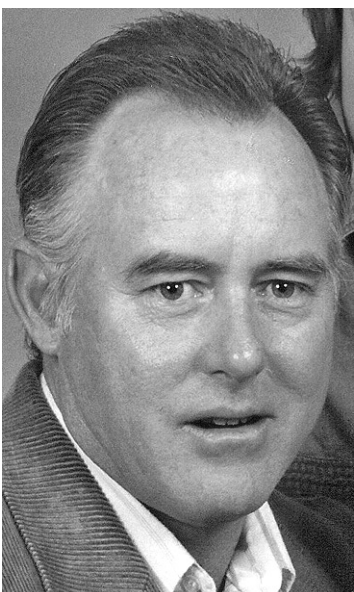
SULPHUR SPRINGS: Delma Howard died Wednesday morning, November 14, 2012, at Hopkins County Memorial Hospital.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her great granddaughter, Zoey Stewart.

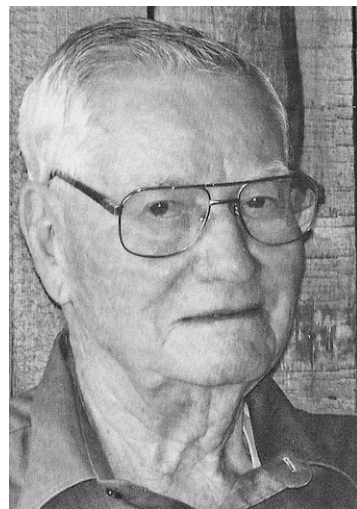
