**1920-2012**

*ALVORD:* Charles C. "Chet" Haney, 91, of Alvord, a retired glass glazier, died on Friday, December 30, 2011, in Bowie.

Chet was born August 1, 1920, in Baxter County, Arkansas to Bryan and Delphia (Heiskill) Haney. He served in the United States Army during World War II and he received the Purple Heart. Chet was united in marriage to Mildred F. Greenwood on January 7, 1946, in Alvord.

Chet retired from Binswanger Glass Company in Dallas after 30 years of service as a glass glazier. After his retirement, he worked 5 years as a business agent for the Glazier Local Union No. 1837. Chet was a member of the Masonic Lodge in Dallas for over 50 years and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Alvord.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years, Mildred of Alvord; daughter, Barbara "Corkey" Shepherd of Alvord; brother, Ray Dean Haney of Grand Prairie; sister, Nita Ray of Edmond, Oklahoma; five grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; and 11 great-great-grandchildren.

Chet is preceded in death by his parents, daughter, Sue Haney; three brothers, and two sisters.
