BRIDGEPORT: George Johnson Hogue, 66, of Bridgeport, died Sunday, February 19, 2012, in Denton, Texas, of complications from intestinal cancer.

George was born November 22, 1945, in Altus, Oklahoma, to Ralph S. and Freddie B. (Johnson) Hogue. He graduated from Decatur High School in 1964. George married Waynda O'Dell in Bridgeport, on November 24, 1967. He worked most of his life as an electrician at Mitchell Energy in Wise County, Texas. He retired from Bridgeport Tank Trucks in 2010. He was a member of the Australasian Order of Old Bastards, a fraternal organization based in Australia with members throughout the world. He was an avid Ham radio operator. He taught himself electronics and worked with home computers, beginning with a HeathKit computer he built in his garage. He was also actively involved in shooting sports and hand loading.

Survivors include his wife; one daughter, Jenny Kimball of Grand Prairie; his mother, Freddie Hogue of Dexter, Missouri; one brother, James Hogue and his wife, Rayla of Clarksburg, Missouri; and nephew Jimtu Hogue of Clarksburg.

He is also survived by two granddogs, Wolfgang Spartikus and Bluebonnet Sage; three grandcats, Rasputin Earl, Samuel Thomas, and Freddie Roger, as well as several canine, feline, and equine nieces and nephews of Clarksburg.

He was preceded in death by his father, Ralph S. Hogue and his maternal grandparents, Vick and Faye Johnson.
