BRIDGEPORT: Ernest "Burt" Lancaster, 84, a repairman, died Saturday, November 3, 2012, in Bridgeport.

Burt was born on May 11, 1928, to Jesse and Ettie (Young) Lancaster, in Eastland, Texas. He served his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII.
