1933-2012

DECATUR: Aline "Dora" Manire, 79, a retired hairdresser, died Wednesday, October 24, 2012, in Decatur.

Dora was born February 19, 1933, to Broe and Della (Claborn) Ray. She was the great-granddaughter of Mose P. and Lavina Ball who came to Wise County in early 1850. They helped settle the northern part of Wise County.

Dora was united in marriage to Leon "Leaky" Manire in 1955, and was married 22 years at his death on January 11, 1977.

She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution; Wise County Historical Society; Decatur Senior Citizen's Center; The First Baptist Church of Decatur; and the Red Hat Group. Dora was a volunteer for Solaris Hospice Healthcare and Decatur Nursing Home. Dora was the first woman to serve on a jury in Wise County.

Survivors include her daughter, Fonda O'Connor and husband, Mike, of Weatherford; son, Troy Manire, of Decatur; loving granddaughter, Danni O'Connor, of Weatherford; sister-in-law, LaVerna Manire, of Weatherford; and numerous nieces, nephews and a host of friends.

Funeral service was held at 10:30 a.m. Monday, October 29, 2012, at Coker-Hawkins Funeral Home Chapel with Reverends Ken May and Gerre Joiner officiating. Interment was at Oaklawn Cemetery.
