GREENWOOD: Carlton Mann, 74, of Greenwood, Texas, formerly of Bridgeport, died April 21, 2012 in Plano, Texas.

Carlton was born January 4, 1938, in Decatur, Texas to Mary (Carlton) and Frank Mann, who were dairy farmers in the Bluett community. Carlton, however, devoted his career to children. After receiving his Masters Degree from the University of North Texas, he was a school teacher for many years, and later became assistant superintendent at Bridgeport ISD before retiring after 41 years of service. He married Virginia Ann Pinkerton in Marietta, Oklahoma, on April 11, 1959. Carlton was a member of the Singing Oaks Church of Christ. He loved cattle ranching and the outdoors, and he loved his family very much. He served his country in the Army National Guard from 1956 to 1970.

Survivors include his wife of 53 years; daughter Janet Gail Mann Armstrong and husband, Neil, of Bridgeport; son, Brent Edward Mann, of Greenwood; grandchildren Alyssa Diane Armstrong and Sage Cheyenne Mann; great-grandsons Pierce Charles Carman and Tate Ryan Lingo; brothers: Burt Ellis Mann, of Odessa, Texas and L.W. Mann, of Alvord, Texas; sisters: Christelle Mann Martin and Frankie Mann Miliara, both of Lewisville, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his sister Fidella Mann Gage.
