BRIDGEPORT: Ambrose B. Plucker, 91, formerly of Neenah, Wisconsin, a salesman, died Thursday, May 9, 2013, in Bridgeport, Texas.

Ambrose was born on September 21, 1921, to Richard and Matilda (Sell) Plucker, in Neenah, Wisconsin. He served his country as a lieutenant in the Army Air Force as a pilot in World War II. Ambrose was united in marriage to Eunice Hopkins on April 1, 1944, in Sakeston, Missouri and they just celebrated their 69th wedding anniversary. Ambrose was a salesman for Kimberly Clark and retired after 30 years.
