RUNAWAY BAY: Chuck “General” Tanner, 74, a retired U.S. Air Force Chief Master Sergeant, died Wednesday, April 3, 2013, in Runaway Bay.

Chuck was born on June 2, 1938, to Chalmer and Gertrude (Cornelius) Tanner, in Coleman County, Alabama. He served his country in the U.S. Air Force.
