1918 - 2014

BRIDGEPORT: Edna McPhail Baker, 95, died Tuesday, July 22, 2014.

Edna was born in North Carolina and grew up picking cotton and hanging tobacco in the barns. She was the valedictorian of her high school class. After high school she became a registered nurse and joined the United States Army. While stationed in San Juan she met Frank H. Baker. They were married in 1943 in a 400 year old chapel at El Morrow.

She was an office/surgical nurse for Dr. Collins, an ophthalmologist. She certified as an audiologist and opened her own business, Baker Hearing Aids.

The last ten years of her life Edna lived in Texas, but she always considered Macon, Georgia her home and Vineville United Methodist her church.

Edna was preceded in death by her husband, Frank H. Baker and her youngest child, Lee Baker.

She is survived by Edna and J.C. Guthmiller of Chico; grandsons: Andy and Matthew Schoppert, both of Dallas; Scott and Kim Schoppert and daughter, June, of Austin; Frank and Wendy Baker and their children, Kensey and Harrington, of Atlanta, Georgia; granddaughters: Rosy Baker of Los Angeles, California and Wynn Baker of Frisco, Texas and their mother, Barbara Wood of Frisco. She has two surviving sisters: Christine Smith of Geneva, Alabama and Willodene Stevenson of Fayetteville, North Carolina.
