*BRIDGEPORT:* Jimmy Dale Brewer, 59, a retired delivery man, died Friday, December 5, 2014 in Bridgeport at Stagecoach Rehabilitation.

Jimmy was born on August 31, 1955 to E.J. “Bill” and Nellie Katherine “Mollie” (Dethloff) Brewer in Bridgeport. He was a lifelong resident of Bridgeport where he worked for Hartsell Feed Store, Gifford Hill Rock Crusher, Chico Crushed Stone, Dnya Mud Drilling, A&T Bearing and the *Bridgeport Index*. At a very young age, Jimmy Dale followed his family and joined the First United Methodist Church of Bridgeport.
