BRIDGEPORT: Oran K. Goode, 79, a retired safety coordinator, died Sunday, May 18, 2014 in Bridgeport.

Oran was born on December 3, 1934 to Kossie and Lillie (Buckingham) Goode in Electra, Texas. He was united in marriage to Myrna Ross on June 25, 1960 in Bridgeport.
