CHICO: Lonnie Joel Vandergriff, 64, a home builder and rock and brick mason, died Saturday, December 28, 2013 in Chico.

Lonnie was born on June 9, 1949 to Junior Lee and Azell (Morgan) Vandergriff in Fort Worth. He was united in marriage to Diana Weinheimer on December 31, 1994 in Decatur.
