CHICO: William Paul Vernon, Jr. was born April 17, 1927 in Alexandria, Louisiana to the late Elizabeth and William Paul Vernon, Sr. He died at home February 19, 2014 at the age of 86.

Mr. Vernon worked ten years for the city of Fort Worth tax department. He retired from the Federal Housing Administration after 20 years, and worked seven years as an independent appraiser.

He served in the US Navy during WWII on a troop and supply ship in the South Pacific. Returning home he came to Fort Worth, Texas to study architectural and mechanical drafting on the GI Bill.

He met his wife Maudene (Underwood) Vernon in Fort Worth. They were married 64 years.

He is survived by his wife Maudene of Chico, Texas; son David Paul Vernon of Chico; sister Ouita McCaa and husband, Buddy of Farmers Branch, Texas; several nieces and nephews; brother, Arnold Vernon of California; and brother-in-law, Wayne Underwood of Kennewick, Washington.

He was preceded in death by his younger brother, Charles Vernon.

Paul was a member of Pleasant View Baptist Church in Bridgeport for 28 years. His ashes will be buried in the Thomas Cemetery at a later date.
