MARLOW: Norma Jean Mitchum White, 92, of Marlow died Thursday, September 4, 2014, in Marlow.

Norma was born Monday, August 28, 1922, in Rush Springs to Thomas Troy and Hattie Anne (Myers) Mitchum. She spent her early years in Oklahoma, then moved with her family to Bridgeport, Texas. Norma Jean graduated from Bridgeport High School in May of 1940. On November 1, 1941, Norma married A.C. White in Bridgeport. He preceded her in death on March 16, 2003.

Her greatest joy was in raising her sons and spending time with her family. She loved to cook and was an accomplished quilter. She completed 28 quilts as gifts for family members. Norma enjoyed going to the Marlow Senior Citizens Center and was a longtime member of the Southern Baptist Church in Rush Springs.

Norma was preceded in death by her parents; a son, Thomas White; six brothers, Mark, Homer, Bruce, Thomas, Joe Bill and Thomas Troy Mitchum, Jr. (KIA Germany 1945) and five sisters, Edra, Gerrie, Hazel, Tora and Maxine.

Survivors include two sons and daughters-in-law: Burl and Linda White of Duncan and Kenneth and Billie White, of Marlow and many grandchildren and great grandchildren. Norma Jean is remembered fondly by classmates and her nephew Robert Marlett of the Bridgeport area.
