**WAXAHACHIE:** J. K. (Jiles Kenchen) Boone, 85, died Tuesday morning, June 9, 2015 at Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas, Texas.

Born July 19, 1929, to Jiles Kenchen, Sr. and Charlotte McGee (Childress) Boone in Elgin, Texas.

In 1947, he graduated from Elgin High School where he played football and was named All District Tight End and All Central Texas Tight End in 1946.
