FORT WORTH: Asie Lee Rhodes, 91, died on March 2, 2015.

Asie Lee was born to Henry and Minnie Stockton on September 30, 1923 in Whitesboro, Texas. As a child, she and her family moved by covered wagon from Whitesboro to Nubbin Hill, Arkansas.

When World War II shattered her peaceful country life, she joined the Corps of Engineers secretarial staff in the Pentagon working in Washington, DC. Asie Lee was later transferred to Alaska to help establish the Corps of Engineers office; coordination while the Alaska Highway was being constructed.

At the completion of her assignments, Asie Lee moved to Prescott where she married her sweetheart, Ivy Ray Rhodes, and they moved to Fort Worth, Texas.
