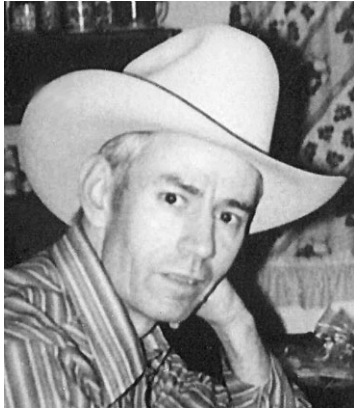


FRANK ALBERT EISENMAN, JR.
