Louis Lawrence "Larry" Moorman, 85, of Aurora, died November 30, 2006 in Bridgeport.

Mr. Moorman was born July 5, 1921 in Dormont, PA to Louis and Mary Lee Moorman. A graduate of Carnegie Mellon Institute, he enlisted in the Navy, and was in charge of the engine room on the USS New Jersey. He was in the mutual fund business, first as a wholesaler, then as Senior Executive Vice President for Integrated Resources in California. His first wife Doris and he had three children, Jim, Merry Lee and Barbara Sue. After Doris's death he married Harriett Smart, and adopted her daughter, Elizabeth Ann. He was a member of First United Methodist Church of Boyd, where he was active, serving as Treasurer for many years, and involved in the Bible Study classes, as well as the building of the new sanctuary.
