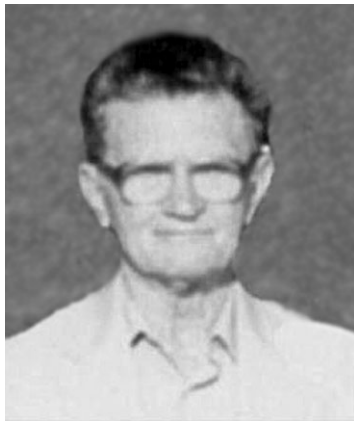


ROGER TRAN RAY
