Stanley Jagers, 73, of Quanah, died December 31, 2005.

Mr. Jagers was born October 29, 1932 in Mt. Pleasant, to the late Worth and Loretta Redfern Jagers. He married Lou Branum on January 28, 1955 in Honey Grove.

A 1951 graduate of Mt. Vernon High School, he attended Paris Junior College and received a BA degree from Southern State University in Magnolia, Arkansas. He also received a master's degree in education from Texas A&M at Commerce. He was a coach and principal at Bridgeport from 1963 to 1968. He was a longtime resident of Quanah and retired as superintendent of the Quanah School District in 1995.

Mr. Jagers was a U.S. Navy veteran of the Korean Conflict and a member of the Quanah Masonic Lodge and Maskat Temple in Wichita Falls. He served on the Quanah City Council and the Harden County Appraisal District Board of Directors. He was a past president of the Lions Club and was named Quanah Citizen of the Year in 1978 and Man of the Year in 1994.

Survivors include his wife; daughters, Patti Hayes of Richmond and Janna White of Rockwall; son, Chuck Bradley Jagers of Plano; brothers, Don Kenneth Jagers and Jack Jagers of Mt. Vernon; and nine grandchildren.

Funeral service was January 2, 2006 at the First United Methodist Church with the Rev. Bud Kidwell officiating. Interment was in Quanah Memorial Park.
